INSPIRE Implementation

- Polish and Cross-Border Experiences -

The main effort of the organizations responsible for the implementation of the EU INSPIRE Directive in Poland is nowadays reconstructing several elements of the national spatial information infrastructure. It covers all alterations to the legal regulation, but also restructuring existing public registers and their databases, as well as changes in organizational support of the infrastructure.

The problem of harmonization of existing data resources to the INSPIRE implementing rules will be discussed in the context of the strategy for implementing INSPIRE in Poland. The role of the official cartography is redefined as well as its influence by the process of introducing new geoinformation modeling to the practice.

There will be presented also the scope and progress in cross-border cooperation of the Surveyor General of Poland and three geodetic and cartographic authorities in Brandenburg, Mecklenburg and Saxony.
